

**ARCHDIOCESE OF LOUISVILLE CATHOLIC SCHOOLS
 DELAYED OPENING/EARLY DISMISSAL POLICIES
 October 2017**

INCLEMENT WEATHER: The decision to close schools due to weather conditions will be announced via radio and TV for the Catholic schools of Jefferson County. Catholic schools outside Jefferson County will follow the local public school announcements or their own announced procedure. One of the following announcements will be made:

1. All Catholic elementary and high schools in Jefferson County are **OPEN.**
2. Catholic elementary and high schools in Jefferson County will be **OPEN BUT ON A DELAYED SCHEDULE.**
3. All Catholic elementary and high schools in Jefferson County are **CLOSED.**

DELAYED SCHEDULE: Each administrator, after consultation with the local school board or equivalent decision-making group, will determine a **DELAYED SCHEDULE** for the individual school. Written notice about how the school will react to all inclement weather announcements will be given to all persons affected by the decision. Please see the chart below for the delayed schedule start time for each Catholic elementary school.

EARLY DISMISSAL-ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS: No public announcements will be made about early dismissal in Jefferson County Catholic elementary schools except in the case of extreme emergency. Each administrator, after consultation with the local school board or equivalent decision-making group, will determine an early dismissal policy and communicate it in writing to all persons affected by the decision.

Please see information about the delayed opening and early dismissal policy of each Catholic elementary school in the chart below. Elementary schools are listed by county. Secondary school information can be found on page seven.

Immaculata Classical Academy	9:30 a.m. (Doors open at 9:00 a.m.)		All closings, early dismissals, and delays will be announced independently under the name Immaculata Classical Academy. Information will be sent via WDRB Snow Fox text alerts, and families also will receive an email.
John Paul II	9:55 a.m.	✓	If Archdiocese decides to release schools early, parents/guardians are contacted via Reach Alert.
Nativity Academy	9:45a.m. (Doors open at 9:00 a.m.)	✓	On early release days, Nativity remains in school until 3:15 p.m. There is no Extended Day Program when early release is called. Nativity uses email and phone calls to notify parents of early release situations.
Notre Dame Academy	10:00 a.m. (Doors open 9:15 a.m.)	✓	If a delayed start occurs on an already scheduled 12:30 p.m. dismissal day, the 12:30 dismissal will be canceled and classes will be dismissed at the normal time of 2:40. If a delay is called on an 11:00 a.m. dismissal day, NDA will not have school.
Our Lady of Lourdes	10:00 a.m. (Doors open at 9:30 a.m.)	✓	An announcement will be sent through emails, posted on Sycamore, and text messages will be sent. Pre-School will follow the school schedule for delayed opening; Aftercare will make decision on early dismissal and will contact parents.
Pitt Academy	10:00 a.m. (Doors open at 9:30 a.m.)	✓	In the event of extremely inclement weather developing during the course of a school day, school may be dismissed early. If this becomes necessary, parents/guardians will be called by Pitt staff members to pick up their children. There will be no after-school care if school is dismissed early.
Sacred Heart Model School	9:30 a.m. (Doors open at 9:00 a.m.)		When high schools dismiss early, Sacred Heart Model dismisses at the same time.
Saint Agnes	10:00 a.m.	✓	When warranted due to inclement weather or any other emergency, parents will be contacted through the emergency alert system. On days when there is a delayed opening the doors will open at 9:15 AM. Buses will also be on a two hour delay.
Saint Albert the Great	8:50 a.m.	✓	St. Albert will keep parents informed with Rediker, the school information system.
Saint Andrew Academy	9:50 a.m.	✓	St. Andrew Academy will keep parents informed through the school's website, Sycamore site, and through the school's Facebook page.
Saint Athanasius	9:50 a.m. (Doors open at 9:10 a.m.)	✓	If there is a delayed start, please listen to the radio/TV announcements. Classes will begin at 9:50 a.m., with the doors opening at 9:10 a.m. Please see the handbook for detailed information. In case of an extreme emergency, parents will be contacted via the Community Safe Notification System. If school is dismissed early, SAFE will close at 4:00 p.m.

Saint Bernard	10:00 a.m. (Doors open 9:00 a.m.)	✓	On delayed opening days, school doors open at 9:00 a.m. and classes begin at 10:00 a.m. There is no supervision before 9:00 a.m.
Saint Edward	9:30 a.m.	✓	Doors open at 9:00 a.m. No supervision before 9:00 a.m.
Saint Francis of Assisi	10:00 a.m. (Doors open 9:30 a.m.)	✓	If a delayed start occurs on an already scheduled noon dismissal day, the noon dismissal will be cancelled and classes will be dismissed at the normal time of 3:00 p.m. The noon dismissal day will not be rescheduled. This is true for all noon dismissal days except the one in January set for conferences; we must still dismiss at noon in order for conferences to take place as scheduled.

Students will not be released early unless parents have been contacted.

When it is warranted, due to inclement weather or to any other emergency, parents will be contacted via our emergency alert system.
Saint Paul	9:50 a.m. (Doors open at 9:00 a.m.)	✓	When weather becomes a hazard once school has begun, we will not dismiss early. Parents may call the school and make arrangements to pick their child up if they feel it is necessary. If a delayed start occurs on an early dismissal day, school will dismiss at the normal time.
Saint Raphael	9:30 a.m. (Doors open at 9:00 a.m.)	✓	Should school be dismissed early, parents will be notified through the Reach Alert System and Sycamore. Students will not be released early unless parent has been contacted.
Saint Rita	Classes start at 9:50 a.m. (Doors open at 9:00 a.m.)		Early dismissal will be communicated through Rediker.
Saint Stephen Martyr	9:00 a.m. (Doors open at 8:15 a.m.)	✓	If a winter storm or other emergency develops after children are in school, and the Superintendent of Schools recommends early dismissal, announcements will be aired on radio and TV. The school also will notify parents through the website and Reach Alert about changes to the school day. Monitoring of children will be provided until all have left the building safely. In the case of an early dismissal, parents who have children in daycare can keep their children there if necessary. If the school is on a delayed schedule, PreK will open at 8:00 a.m.

FOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN JEFFERSON COUNTY: If inclement weather develops during the course of a school day, the superintendent’s office will make a decision regarding an early dismissal for Catholic high schools in Jefferson County. If an early dismissal is necessary, the superintendent's office will contact the high schools and the radio and television stations with the announcement, “Catholic high schools in Jefferson County will dismiss at 1:30 p.m.” If inclement weather conditions necessitate a change in the 1:30 p.m. early dismissal time, the superintendent’s office will make that decision and communicate the dismissal time to the high schools and the radio and television stations.
