The new translation of The Order of Baptism of Children was approved by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops and confirmed by the Apostolic See for use in the dioceses of the United States of America beginning April 2020.

New features in this revised edition include:

- The text of an optional introduction
- The addition of a simple acclamation after each baptism
- Rubrics which incorporate adaptations made in previous USCCB editions
- An option to expand the Litany of the Saints
- A new appendix with the Baptism of Children within Mass (with a detailed outline).
- Some prayers have slight variations in translations The Anointing after Baptism, the Clothing with the White Garment, the Handing on of a Lighted Candle, and the Ephphatha rite. Portions of the new translation may already be found in the 2011 Roman Missal: Easter Vigil.
- Chapter Seven contains the options for readings, acclamations, petitions, and prayer formulas.
