Awareness Weekends - Sept. 23/24, Sept. 30/Oct. 1

The purpose of Awareness Weekends is to generate enthusiasm and support for the Appeal. These weekends provide Pastors and their CSA Appeal teams the opportunity to remind parishioners of their connectedness to the ministries and services of the larger local Church (Archdiocese). It also provides an opportunity to offer concrete connections between the parish and the work of the Archdiocese. We are One Church, made up of 110 Parishes.

The In-Pew Weekend - October 7/8

Perhaps one of the most important aspects of the Catholic Services Appeal are the pulpit presentations, especially the Pastor's presentation. The In-Pew Weekend effort is a proven way to inform, inspire and invite donors to support the CSA. When parishioners hear the Pastor speak about the Appeal from the pulpit, they are more motivated to give. The In-Pew process allows donors to take immediate action on what they just heard. This weekend also reaches the unregistered churchgoer who will not have received the Archbishop's invitation to support the Catholic Services Appeal or the Pastor's letter.

Follow-Up Weekend - October 14/15

Parishes are encouraged to consider using this weekend as a follow-up or second In-Pew Weekend. Many people do not attend Mass at their home parish each weekend. The Follow-Up Weekend offers parishes the opportunity to speak briefly about the Appeal and provide parishioners with another opportunity to respond with a gift. A CSA envelope will be inserted into the October 19 edition of *The Record*.

WHY THE CATHOLIC SERVICES APPEAL IS IMPORTANT

Individuals, families, parishes, and schools benefit from the work of Archdiocesan agencies and offices. Below is a small sample of the many works supported by the Appeal over the last year.

- Developed and maintained, in collaboration with the Office of Mission Advancement and Archdiocesan Communications Office, a new podcast series "What's New in ArchLou," a monthly podcast series to highlight the people and ministries of the Archdiocese of Louisville.
- Held safe environment training workshops or provided emergency video options for 2,831 staff and volunteers who work with children or youth.
- Hosted the 2022 annual convention of the National Association of Pastoral Musicians, the first virtual convention for 1,200 online participants.
- Celebrated 17 national and regional awards for The Record, including six first-place awards, from the Catholic Press Association and the Society of Professional Journalists.
- Coordinated the preparation and electronic mailing of *The Catholic Connection*, a monthly electronic newsletter sent to more than 31,513 households.
- Provided a virtual platform for 800 persons nationwide to discuss life and human dignity and the sin of racism. Two hundred thirty individuals are now meeting to address future directions on the local level.
- Led a community-wide Stations of the Cross: Overcoming Racism (SotCOR) via Zoom on Fridays during Lent. This resource was designed by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.
- Expanded information about the Archives office and its services on www.archlou.org. Updates include a series of "how tos," e.g. how to request sacramental records, how to submit a historical research request, how to donate archival material; information about the Archdiocese of Louisville History Center; and other helpful resources. Other information will be added in phase two of this update.
- Published a regular monthly section of The Record in Spanish Vida Catolica that is bulk-shipped directly to parishes with Hispanic populations.
- Offered 133 catechist certification classes (retreats, workshops and classes) for 1,333 attendees (teachers, parish catechists, principals, parish catechetical leaders, and others in ministry).
- Provided 22,679 interactions through Long-Term Ombudsman and language services.
- Provided 9,623 instances of Food Pantry interactions through the Sister Visitor Center.
- Welcomed 2,158 donor households into the 2022 Salt & Light Giving Society for the Catholic Services Appeal.

Some additional CSA "fast facts" that could be used to customize the General Mass Announcement are below.

- Funding from the Catholic Services Appeal helped welcome 372 new Catholics (171 Candidates and 201 Catechumens) into the Church last year through the RCIA program with the Office of Faith Formation.
- Funding from the Catholic Services Appeal provided marriage preparation and enrichment classes and/or retreats for 231 couples in the past year.
- Funding from the Catholic Services Appeal provides formation for the priesthood for 17 seminarians.
- Funding from the Catholic Services Appeal provided Safe Environment Training for 2,831 staff and volunteers who work with children or youth in the past year.
- Funding from the Catholic Services Appeal helped serve 9,623 individuals through the Food Pantry at the Sister Visitor Center last year.

2023 STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESS

Developing a Strategy for Success relies on 5 key items:

1. Leadership of Pastors

A) Pastor support for the Catholic Services Appeal is the single most important factor in determining a parish's success. Pastors set the tone for the appeal with their endorsement, enthusiasm and encouragement.

2. Case for Support

- A) Offer stories on ways your parish benefits from archdiocesan ministries and services e.g. administrative support, training, grants, and program sponsorships.
- B) Consider having parishioners or a staff member speak at Masses on the Appeal Awareness Weekends, describing how they have benefited from archdiocesan ministries and services. The presentation should be brief but more than just an announcement.
- C) Show the CSA video as often as possible, at Masses, parish meetings, on the parish website, school website, social media, etc. Encourage parishioners to visit the archdiocesan website at www.ArchLou.org/CSA to view the CSA video and learn more about the Appeal.
- D) Suggest that teachers and religious education catechists propose a class project or learning experience focused on the ministries/services of the Archdiocese.

3. Enlist a Parish Appeal Team and Witness Speakers

A) The Parish Appeal Team can provide valuable assistance to the pastor in promoting the Catholic Services Appeal and conducting a successful In-Pew effort.

4. Promote Pledges and Increased Giving

- A) Pledges allow the donor to make a larger gift based on his/her ability to pay over a period of several months up to June 2024. Example: A one-time gift is usually based on cash in hand, such as \$20, however 8 monthly gifts of \$20 each by June 2024 = \$160 gift.
- B) Inform donors about the various payment options available to make a gift:
 - Cash, Check, Credit Card, Electronic Transfer from checking account, online giving, by scanning the QR code, stocks, etc. Remind donors to ask their employer if they offer matching gifts.

5. Recurring Gift Option

- A) Monthly recurring gifts allow donors to make their gift through convenient automatic deductions from their credit card, debit card or checking account.
- B) Recurring gifts allow the donors to divide their gift into manageable increments.

6. Provide Multiple Opportunities for Donors to Respond

- A) Don't be reluctant to request a gift from those who have said "no" in the past. People may be ready to give at a later date. Follow-up requests in November and December often meet with success.
- B) The In-Pew process has been shown to be a highly effective method of generating many gifts to CSA.

 Many new In-Pew gifts are made by Mass attendees who are not in the Archdiocese's database, and would therefore not receive Appeal information by mail.
- C) Consider having an "Over-the-Top" weekend to remind parishioners that the parish is close to goal and ask that they help push you over goal that very week.
- D) Remind parishioners that each parish also has a donor participation goal in addition to a monetary goal. Encourage everyone to participate. Every gift, no matter the size, is important to the Catholic Services Appeal.
