Position Summary:

Under the direction of the Director of Facilities and the Head of Maintenance, oversees the day-today operation of the entire physical plant and cleaning/maintenance staff of all buildings owned and operated by the Archdiocese of Louisville.

Primary Duties and Responsibilities:

- Responsible for maintenance of and the performance of all necessary repairs to all electrical, plumbing, HVAC and emergency systems, windows, doors, equipment, grounds, Etc.
- Develop and maintain all pertinent documentation relating to facilities related activities and equipment.
- Help maintain a preventive maintenance schedule on all equipment.
- Co-ordinate with and assist cleaning personnel and/or contractor.
- As directed by the Head of Maintenance, take competitive bids from contractors and submit for review.
- Oversee work from approved outside contractors, help maintain required vendor documentation as requested by the Head of Maintenance.
- Procure all necessary supplies, parts, equipment and services within budgetary guidelines and maintain an appropriate inventory of common supplies and parts.
- Assist in procuring any requested information for annual budget process.
- Follow all applicable government regulations, safety and emergency evacuation procedures, and Archdiocesan policies and procedures.
- Perform other related duties as may be assigned by the Head of Maintenance and occasionally the Director of Facilities.
