Holy Trinity faculty members' degrees and experience:

- 83% of our faculty are KY State Certified with a Master's degree in Education. All other teachers are KY State Certified and working toward their Master's degree
- 28 of our Master level teachers also have 15+ years of experience

Holy Trinity is one of the largest parochial Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of Louisville with a total enrollment of 816 students (732 at St. Matthews Campus + 84 at Clifton Campus).

- Holy Trinity offers a core curriculum of Religion, Reading, Math, Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies, as well as weekly resource classes in Spanish, Technology, Art, Physical Education, Music, and Library
- 72% of our students score above grade level in Reading Comprehension, based on current Fall Map Assessment scores
- 95% of our students participate in one or more of our athletic offerings across 20 different sports
- 40% of our students participate in our drama & musical theater productions
- Holy Trinity students have unique access to specialized academic and operational faculty/staff not available to many schools in the Archdiocese – two Directors of Student Achievement, two School Counselors, a Reading Resource Teacher, a Math Specialist, a Director of Student Activities, and a School Nurse
- Our Service Learning Program is a program based on the seven principles of Catholic Social Teaching. The
 program involves all grade levels serving social service programs in our community. The program teaches
 our students a variety of ways in which they use their gifts and talents to serve others now and in the future.

The Holy Trinity budget for the 2025-2026 fiscal year is financially sound, with three endowments generating approximately \$100,000 per year to apply to Parish and/or school expenses.
